Pregnancy Specific Resources

WIC 979-260-2942

Provides supplemental food program for qualifying women who are pregnant or breastfeeding and for children up to 5 years of age. Provides breastfeeding classes, breastfeeding support, breast pumps, and nutrition education.

Nurse-Family Partnership Program 844-637-6667

Helps first-time moms who are less than 28 weeks pregnant find resources and get connected with free nurse services.

Aggieland Pregnancy Outreach 979-764-6636

A Christian ministry that offers adoption services, housing referrals, and the Mama Club for new moms under 21

Pride Community Center 979-217-1324

Offers services for the LGBTQI+ (Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Questioning - anyone of marginalized sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression) community in the Brazos Valley including social support, anti-bullying, advocacy, and safe space events.

Faith-based organization offering help with infant needs (diapers, clothes, etc), domestic violence advocacy, and job preparedness.
